Call for papers

Papers related to the conference theme: ***Egypt, Sudan and Beyond*** are now invited.

The CIPEG Annual Meeting 2021 will again be online due to the persistence of the pandemic situation in many countries. The announced Sudan exhibition at the Louvre has been postponed to 2022, but we will keep the Sudan theme in anticipation of its opening. The chosen theme “Egypt, Sudan and Beyond” will allow a focus on different topics such as research, as well as collaborative projects between international institutions. Secondly, we would like to invite talks about Sudanese archaeological collections in a panel devoted to “Displaying Nubian collections”. And thirdly, we will introduce a new programme called Museum Matters that will be officially inaugurated with a surprise act.

Abstracts should be submitted as Word files and include your name, title, institutional affiliation (if applicable) and full contact details.

Looking forward to the future, the third day of the conference will be dedicated to the second Young CIPEG Meeting, which aims to bring together aspiring young museum professionals from around the world, with established ones in the field. It will provide a forum for the discussion of museology matters, including career pathways, the changing role of museums, ethics and museum practice, as they relate to the study of Egyptian and Sudanese collections, and an opportunity for young people to voice their opinions and seek career guidance. This year’s topic will be museum education. The full programme will follow soon.
