The CIPEG Journal: Ancient Egyptian & Sudanese Collections and Museums is a peer-reviewed online journal, dedicated exclusively to scholarly research on ancient Egyptian and Sudanese collections and museums around the world.

The CIPEG Journal publishes the proceedings of CIPEG's annual meetings and associated workshops—including both papers focused on the annual theme, and those based on general museum work—as well as articles presenting general museum work and archaeological excavations conducted by museum-led missions. 'General museum work' includes but is not limited to: the history of Egyptian and Sudanese collections and collectors; object and provenance research; conservation treatments; exhibitions of Egyptian and Nubian art; gallery design and the interpretation of Egyptian and Sudanese collections; development of museum programmes using Egyptian and Sudanese art and collections; and general museum practice and policy in museums with such collections. Contributions not presented at annual meetings or workshops but related to these same research endeavours are also welcome.

**The CIPEG Journal is currently accepting for consideration papers presented at the annual meeting in Kyoto and the associated workshops in Tokyo. Deadline May 1, 2020.**

**All contributions not related to the annual meeting are accepted on a rolling schedule.**
