Accommodation

If you wish to book Swansea University campus accommodation everything is within short walking distance (single ensuite with breakfast £40 per night). Check in after 14.00 check out 10.00. You pay at the Egypt Centre gift shop (cash, cheque or card payment)

For delegates staying in accommodation on site, free parking is available on-site but only for arrivals after 4pm. Delegates can bring their cars onto campus and park in car park 2 or car park 3 ([see map](#)) for the duration of their stay. A temporary parking notice must be collected from Residences Reception at check-in and clearly displayed on the windscreen.

Delegates should proceed to the Recreation Ground car park or Pub on the Pond car park if arriving before 4pm.
