

For Your Flights and Accommodations (As of 08/04/2019)

1. Flight

You can choose an airport from three main international airports below to suit your travel plan.

From/to Tokyo: Narita (<https://www.narita-airport.jp/en/>)

Haneda (<http://www.haneda-airport.jp/inter/en/>)

From/to Kyoto: Kansai (<https://www.kansai-airport.or.jp/en/>)

Note: Some airlines fly from/to only one airport among these three above. Please double-check the websites of airlines and airports.

2. Accommodation (Kyoto)

It would be better to book your accommodations around Kyoto station or along the Karasuma Subway Line (<https://www.kyotostation.com/karasuma-subway-line/>) because the venue of ICOM Kyoto 2019 is located at one of terminal stations of this line. This subway takes you to the venue from Kyoto station directly. Especially between Marutamachi and Imadegawa stations, there are many hotels next to or near the Kyoto Imperial Palace. For your information, Kyoto Garden Palace and The Palace Side Hotel are located very next to the Palace. The following map will show you some other candidates. 3. Accommodation (Tokyo)

If you fly back home from Tokyo-Haneda airport, it would be recommended to book an accommodation in Shinagawa or Hamamatsucho areas. If you take a flight from Tokyo-Narita airport, Ueno and Asakusa areas are recommended.

4. Others

(1) Offsite meeting on 5th September to MIHO MUSEUM

Our bus is departing from Kyoto station at 9:00 and back to Kyoto (probably The National Museum of Modern Art, Kyoto in Okazaki area) around 18:00. MIHO MUSEUM is closed on that day, but the museum kindly opens the museum collection area (i.e. permanent exhibition) for CIPEG and COMCOL. Admission fee is 900 JPY at a group rate. As the restaurants and cafes are also closed, we can ask the museum lunch boxes in advance. The menu and tariff is below. For your information, MIHO MUSEUM again kindly allows us to bring some food and drink to consume in only cafe space only this day for our convenience.
